INDUSTRY NOTIFICATION OF THE PUBLIC ENQUIRY STAGE: DEVELOPMENT OF CROP-SPECIFIC MARKETING AND COMMERCIAL QUALITY CONTROL STANDARDS

The Namibian Agronomic Board (NAB) wishes to inform all producers and traders of horticultural products, and all relevant stakeholders that the Namibian Standards Institution (NSI) Management Technical Committee on Food Safety Management Systems has drafted four (4) Namibian Standards specifying the crop-specific marketing and commercial quality control parameters, as indicated in the table below:

1.	DNAMS 0024:2023	Marketing and commercial quality control of Gem Squash
2.	DNAMS 0025:2023	Marketing and commercial quality control of Sweet Melons
3.	DNAMS 0026:2023	Marketing and commercial quality control of Sweet Corns
4.	DNAMS 0027:2023	Marketing and commercial quality control of Pumpkins

These draft Namibian Standards are now made available to interested parties and the public for comments within 60 days with effect from the date (31st March 2023) of pub-lication in the *Government Gazette* (*GG*8057). Industry stakeholders are therefore en-couraged to participate in the standards development process by obtaining these draft Namibian Standards from the NSI for scrutiny and input within the public notice period.
