INFORMATION SESSION ON THE MILLING LICENCE REQUIREMENTS AND CONDITIONS: AGRONOMIC INDUSTRY ACT 20 OF 1992

The Namibian Agronomic Board (NAB), in collaboration with the Namibian Grain Processors Association (NGPA) extends an invitation to all processors of grain products (mahangu flour, bread wheat flour and white maize meal/flour) for human consumption and commercial trading. Processors are therefore encouraged to register and attend the mandatory information session on the milling licence requirements and conditions scheduled to take place on 20th October 2023 at Okahandja Country Lodge, Okahandja.

This session is tailor-made to inform industry representatives on the legislative requirements applicable to the processing, storage and marketing of grain products in accordance with Section 10(1)(j) of the Agronomic Industry Act No. 20 of 1992. The specific objectives are to:

1. Provide an understanding on the milling licence requirements and conditions, including the requirements to be fulfilled by all economic actors;
2. Enable grain processors (prospective and registered millers, including service millers) to understand basic principles of food hygiene and safety based on the NAMS/SANS 10049 - Food Safety Management: Requirements for Prerequisite Programmes (PRPs) standard;
3. Provide a detailed understanding on the structure of the NAB Audit checklist used as a basis during annual audits;
4. Provide information about the regulations relating to white maize and pearl millet grains and products;
5. Provide feedback on the Outcome of the 2023/24 proximate, pesticide residue and mycotoxins test results analysis of grain products.
